## Summit West Neighborhood District Hosts Wildfire Preparedness Seminars

The Summit West Neighborhood District of Bend is hosting two "Living with Wildfire: Are You Prepared?" seminars alongside multiple preparedness partners to help raise awareness and encourage Central Oregonians to take steps to mitigate wildfire risks this spring.

The seminars will take place on Thursday, March 28 from 3:30 to 5:30 p.m. and from 6 to 8 p.m. Both sessions will be held virtually and in-person in the Brooks Room at the Downtown Bend Library, 601 NW Wall St, Bend. Sessions are identical, free and open to everyone in Central Oregon. In-person seating is limited to 70; virtual seating is unlimited. Local experts will cover topics, including Home Hardening, Defensible Space and Fire-Smart Landscaping, Evacuation Readiness, and How to Become a Firewise® Community.
